-- MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING --

IFAIMA and IFISA are committed to maintaining a close working relationship to further the objectives of our respective organisations in the interest of aviation professionals and, ultimately, aviation safety.


As organisations based on collective strength, we understand the benefits of cooperation and mutual compromise. As we have many shared and common goals, the progress of these goals should remain a topic of continuous collaboration.

The following principles shall be observed in the mutual relationship:

1. Our strategies shall take advantage of the strengths of each organisation and work together to overcome our weaknesses. The issues of division between the responsibilities of AIM personnel and flight information service personnel are not always apparent. Therefore, our relationship shall focus not on the division of responsibility but on collaboration in defining coordination and task objectives.
2. It is recognised that IFAIMA is the premier organisation concerning Aeronautical Information Management, professional and technical matters. It is recognised that IFISA is the premier organisation concerning Flight Information Services, professional and technical matters.
3. The organisations will endeavour to assist in situations where a non-member may require assistance and is a member of the other organisation.
4. Organisations should attempt to maintain a coordinated position where crisis events warrant a response. Nevertheless, each organisation's independence is respected, and neither shall make statements on behalf of the other without consent.

Our organisations are built on the concept of collective strength; what we can do together is much more than what we could achieve alone. We shall understand that there are differences in strategy and objectives, and where difficulties are presented, we will maintain mutual respect, and a focus on the common goal shall be the top priority.

This agreement becomes effective on the date of signing and is subject to renegotiation or cancellation at any point when either party is notified in writing to the other.
